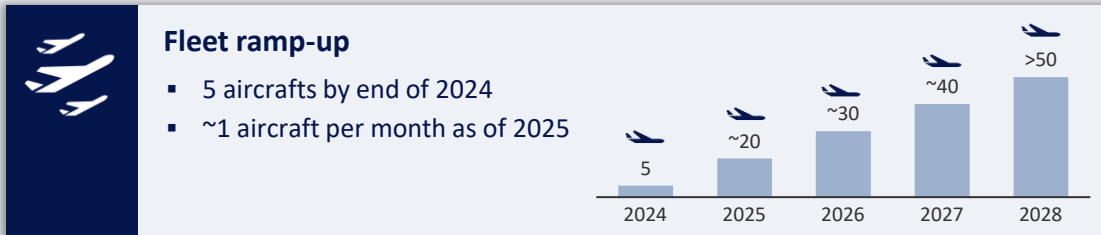

What kind of selection do I have to pass?

- 3 - step selection process acc. EASA and LH Group rules
- With Interpersonal GmbH (IP) and DLR - 2 providers are used to be able to recognize as much as possible

Recognize as much as possible! What does that mean?

If you have already completed one or more selection stages for a Lufthansa airline, you do not necessarily have to repeat them. Have a look on the following table:



Interpersonal GmbH

- Recognition of Basic Qualification (BQ) from a Lufthansa Group airline (Eurowings Germany / Eurowings Ltd. / Discover) – if not older than 60 months
- Recognition Basic Qualification *ip* – if not older than 24 months
- Recognition of SIM Screening from a Lufthansa Group airline (Eurowings Germany / Eurowings Ltd. / Discover) – if not older than 48 months



Deutsches Zentrum für Luft- und Raumfahrt (DLR)

- Recognition of GU/BU and SIM Screening from a Lufthansa Group airline (DLH / CLH / LACG / GWI) – without a limit of time, as long as the result is available



Lufthansa City Airlines | 04 What's in for me?

- Permanent contract from day one
- MyID travel in the LH network from day one
- Access to much more benefits with your new yellow ID Card
- 35 – 42 Holidays (depending on your seniority)
- 116 OFF Days, including 96 fixed days
- Recognition of previous experience as in the following tables:


Is an valid A320 Typerequoting with experience on type required?
